

The list of steps needed to migrate EBI to a new server:

1. Run the Environment Checker on the new server.
2. Install EBI on the new server (but don't open it yet).
3. Create a backup of the "EBI" database and restore it onto the new server.
4. Copy the contents of the \UserData\ (by default: c:\intepub\wwwroot\EBI\UserData\) from the old server to the new one.
5. Copy the WebInstance-XXX.config file from the old server to the new one (by default: c:\inetpub\wwwroot\EBI\WebInstance-YYY.config) and rename it, replacing the existing WebInstance-YYY.config file on the new server.
6. Create the needed ODBC entries on the new server.
7. Open EBI on the new server. It will start in configuration mode. Select the database server and choose the existing database.
8. Apply the new license key.
9. Open the Administrative Panel, choose Global Settings, Other, and click "Recreate LP schedules".
